DIRECTIONS FROM BIRMINGHAM AND THE NORTH

- From Birmingham, the best way is along the **M5 to Junction 11**.
- Take the **A40 towards Gloucester**. This is a dual carriageway.
- At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit sign posted for **Cirencester on the A417**. Carry along this dual carriageway passing under the railway bridge. You will see a pub and a bowling alley on the right hand side.
- At the next roundabout take the **3rd exit sign posted for Gloucester**. Carry straight on this dual carriageway (you will see the Walls factory on your right) to the next roundabout.
- **Go straight on (which is the second exit)** signed posted for the **A38 Gloucester**. You will see the Royal Mail on the right. Go past the speed camera, (it works) over one set of lights and at the next lights turn right (it is marked for **Gloucester City Centre** and it is the A4302). This then takes you into the city centre.
- You go over the railway bridge, passing another speed camera (which also works -limit here is 40 mph) and up to the lights. You will see Asda on the left.
- **Go straight on at these lights**, the road bends round to the left and you come to another set of lights.
- **Turn left here**.
- Carry on, over pelican crossing (you can see Asda on your left) road bends round to right. You come to more lights. **Go straight on** (You will see a large modern warehouse on your left).
- At the next lights **turn right into Park Road**. Carry along Park Road (you have the park on your left) until it ends.
- **Turn right. Go up to traffic lights. Go straight on**. You will see a car park on the right hand side and Gloscat College on your left. You need to take the **first right into St Michael's Square**. As you turn into St Michael's Square, you will see a **red brick building on the corner on your left hand side**. These are the new offices. Car parking is available around the back of the building.
